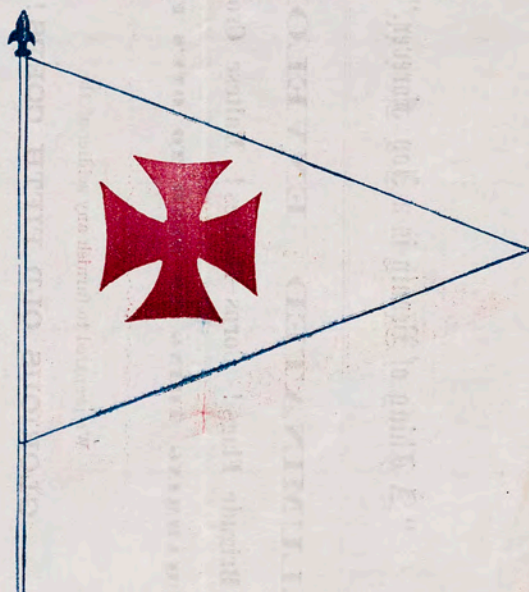


1st Brig., 2d Div., 5th Corps.

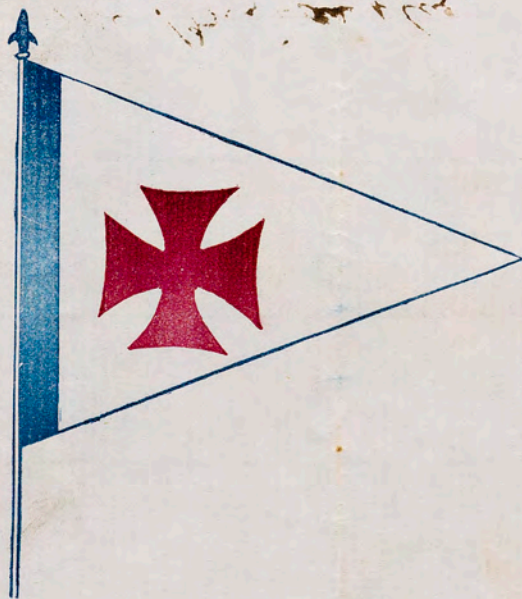

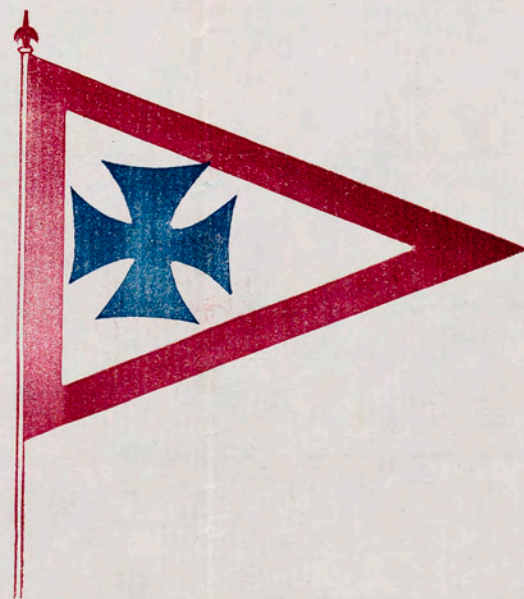

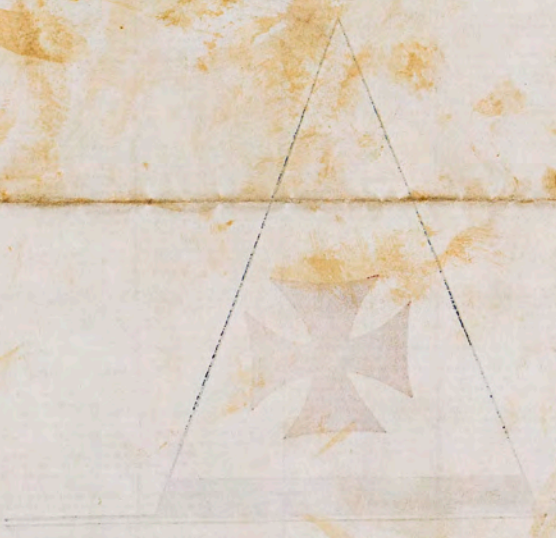
